I am writing to you to ask for your support in my bid to become Leader of the Labour Party.

Labour needs a strong, vibrant and distinctive voice to lead our movement, one that can reach out to all sections of the electorate.

If elected Leader my priorities would be to ensure Labour campaigns to protect people's livelihoods, defends Labour values of equality and social justice and return us back to power. I would vigorously oppose David Cameron and Nick Clegg's vicious cuts agenda.

I would reform trade union legislation in order to restore a level playing field between workers and bosses

I would put an end to further privatisation in the public sector and bring the railways back into public ownership

As a party we need a fresh start, a new beginning. If these values speak to you, vote for me and we can change the party together.

I hope I can rely on your support.
